## Some highlights . . .

### PARKING LOT REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

- Volunteers displaced crumbled asphalt using a skid steer donated by Sunbelt Rentals
- Cornerstone Pavers removed the piles of asphalt off our site
- Landscape plan created by Root Pike Watershed Initiative
- \$55,000 grant awarded toward our \$138,000 parking lot redevelopment project
- BrightView Landscape Services has been maintaining our site since July 2017

#### INSIDE THE BUILDING

#### **CLEAN UP**

- Water damaged walls, ceilings and insulation have been removed and are being replaced in stages with new insulation and drywall
- Electrical panels cleared out ensuring remaining electrical safe. Removed 99% of old florescent lighting ready for new upgraded LED lighting
- Painting inside and out!





#### **WINDOWS**



 Removed broken glass from exterior windows on the north and south sides of our building, framed, and installed white RFP. This was a major undertaking! With its completion we can now turn on our furnaces without the heat literally going out the windows!

#### **CLIENT SHOPPING AREA**



 Removed broken windows and doors, framed, sheeted, insulated and drywalled. Now we have a great space for our clients to "shop" for food and hygiene products.

- Fruit and smoothie bar was made possible through a donation from Skogen's Festival Foods




#### **FILLING THE GAP**
